IS THE CENTRE OPEN?

WHAT IS OPEN AT THE CENTRE?

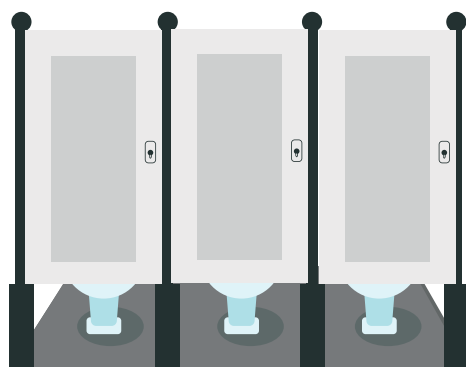
Please keep an eye on our website for details of the stores that are open as this will change regularly in line with the government regulations.

Yes.

ARE YOUR PUBLIC TOILETS OPEN?

Yes, the toilets are open however we have implemented social distancing measures inside the toilets.




DO YOU HAVE HAND SANITISING STATIONS?



Yes, we have installed hand sanitisers at the entrances to the centre. Each store will also have hand sanitisers as you enter the store.

ARE THE PUBLIC SEATING AREAS OPEN?

No, we have removed the seating at the moment, to ensure that social distancing guidelines are adhered to.



IS SOCIAL DISTANCING IN PLACE IN THE CENTRE?

STAY 1 METRES AWAY FROM EACH OTHER,



Yes, we kindly ask that you keep 1m away from the other shoppers while visiting St. George's. We have also implemented a one way system on entering the shopping centre to help with the social distancing. We ask that you follow the signage on entering and inside the centre.

HAS THE CLEANING IN THE CENTRE BEEN INCREASED?

Yes, a revised cleaning regime has been implemented to ensure that the centre is regularly sanitised.



DO I HAVE TO WEAR A FACEMASK IN THE CENTRE?



In accordance with government guidelines, you are required to wear a face-covering in all shops in our shopping centre. If you choose not to wear one any of the retailers are within their rights to refuse you entry into their shop.

IS THE CAR PARK OPEN?

Yes, the car park is still open, we ask that you use contactless payment at the car park machines when possible



IS THERE A ONE WAY SYSTEM?

We have implemented a one way system on entering the shopping centre to help with the social distancing. We ask that you follow the signage on entering and inside the centre.




CAN I SHOP WITH MY FAMILY?

If you need to shop with other members of your household, you can do so. However, in a bid to reduce the spread of coronavirus and to enable social distancing to take place, it is advisable that, where possible, you shop alone.



ARE THE LIFTS IN USE?

Yes, the lifts are still in use but we ask that you only use them on your own or with members of your household. Please prioritise elderly and disabled riders first.



ARE THE ESCALATORS IN USE?

Yes, the escalators are still working but we ask that you keep a 4 step gap between yourself and the person in front.

IS THERE A LIMIT ON THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE THAT CAN BE IN THE CENTRE AT ONCE?

Yes, but you don't need to worry about that. We have staff who will be monitoring the number of people in the centre.
